As one of five designs from the brand's 25th anniversary Precious Metals collection, Native Trails worked with master craftspeople in central Italy to combine age-old artisan culture with modern design. The high-quality bath products are molded from fireclay by expert ceramicists, fired twice at temperatures reaching over 2,200 degrees, then glazed by hand with genuine precious metals, and fired a third time. The sinks are sealed through a proprietary process to ensure they uphold an incredibly fine aesthetic of luxury while also boasting unparalleled durability for long-lasting performance and allure. Undeniably luxurious, generously sized and extremely functional, Bliss will endure the test of time as an heirloom for generations.
