The newly introduced Topanga Series—handcrafted from FSC certified solid walnut—honors the long, rich heritage of Eastern European woodworking. Artisans use a blend of traditional and modern woodworking methods to create captivating cabinets that provide a natural, warm touch and ample storage to a private setting. The vanity's soft-

close, full-extension drawers and soft-close doors reduce noise, withstand daily wear-and-tear, and are durable for use in high-traffic hospitality spaces.

New to the Vintner's Collection—built by American artisans from wine-stained oak staves—are vanities offered in sizes of 36", 48", and a floating vanity with a spacious full-extension, soft-close drawer. The brand also introduced three new finishes that answer to several design aesthetics including Blanc; a versatile, go-to white, Grigio; a cool gray wash, and Noir; an opaque black, as an addition to the series' well-loved light blonde Chardonnay finish.
