Each **Anacapa** sink is individually formed by hand, the result of a multi-day, artisan process. Craftspeople begin by pouring and hand-packing NativeStone®—a proprietary blend of natural jute fiber and cement that is up to 40% lighter than traditional concrete—into custom molds. After curing slowly to ensure strength, each piece is released, then hand-polishing to achieve a satiny, tactile finish.

To enhance performance, every sink is sealed with NativeStone Shield™, a breakthrough sealer that penetrates the surface on a molecular level. Applied by hand in a meticulous, multi-step process, the finish creates an integrated barrier that is scratch-resistant and impervious to water, oils, food, and acids,—while amplifying the natural depth and beauty of the material itself.

Anacapa is offered in ten distinctive finishes: versatile neutrals such as Pearl, Ash, Slate, and Charcoal, alongside nature-inspired hues including Ocean, Sage, Forest, and Terracotta. Together, they allow designers and homeowners to craft organic modern spaces defined by timeless elegance.
