

General Instructions:

We strongly recommend that this product be installed by a professional.

Materials Recommended:

Appropriate hanging hardware for your chosen mounting surface *(Rated for at least 30lbs)*

Tools Needed:

Measuring Tape Pencil Level

1. Select the mounting location for your mirror that will accommodate the size and weight.
2. Decide the orientation of the mirror, with the cross design vertical or diagonal, then note the hanging holes used for that orientation. *(Figure 1)*

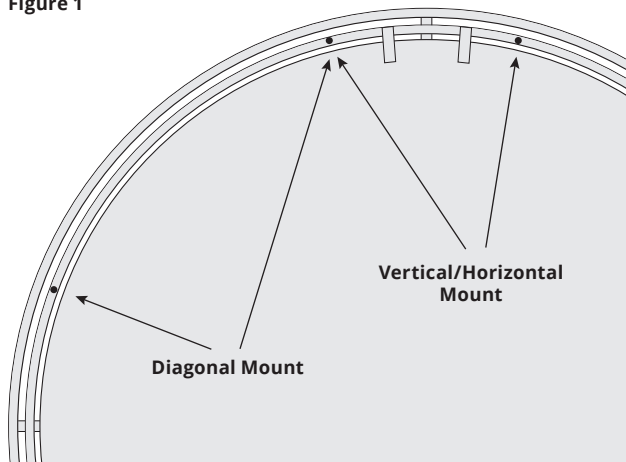
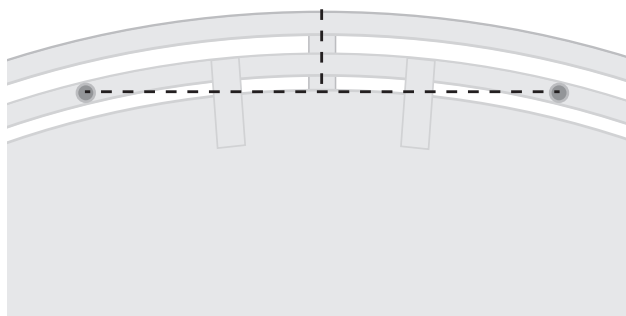

3. On the back of the mirror, measure and record the distance between the desired mounting holes as well as the distance from that line to the top of the mirror. *(Figure 2)*
4. Hold the mirror to the selected mounting location and lightly mark the wall at the top center of the frame. Then, using the previously recorded measurements, mark the wall down where the mounting holes will sit. *(Figure 3)*
5. Install hanging hardware to the markings on the wall according to the manufacturer's instructions, then attach the mirror.
